## **ARP-ESSER III Funds Allocation Plan for Schuyler-Industry #5**

Per ISBE, each school district that receives ARP ESSER funds must develop a plan for its use of ARP ESSER funds and submit it to ISBE within 90 days of funds being received. School districts must provide the public opportunity to provide input on the plan, take such input into account, and post the ARP ESSER plan on its website.

ARP-ESSER III Projected Allocation for Schuyler-Industry School District = \$1,800,421

ARP-ESSER III funds must be used to implement prevention and mitigation strategies that are, to the greatest extent practicable, in line with the most recent CDC guidance, in order to continuously and safely operate schools for in-person learning.

No less than 20 % of the SID5's total allocation of ARP ESSER funds will be used to address the academic impact of lost instructional time during the pandemic on the following items:

- Summer learning opportunities (i.e. teacher salaries and benefits, instructional course licenses, consumable materials for instruction, transportation salaries & benefits, transportation costs, food service salaries and benefits, food service materials)
- After School Tutoring (teacher salaries and benefits, transportation salaries & benefits, transportation costs)
- Professional Development will be offered to teachers and staff in the areas of reading, math, writing, and social and emotional learning.

80% of ESSER III Funds can be used for the district on limited supplies, materials, and projects.

- Curriculum and Instructional Materials
- Installation, labor, and capital outlay for Webster Grade School Construction
- Cleaning Supplies and Equipment
- Transportation Costs (Buses)
- Technology purchases, installation, labor, and capital outlay for various needs within the district.
- Staff salaries and Benefits
