Sports physicals do not satisfy the requirement of a school physical for grades Pre-K, K, 2, 6, and 9.

- HIB series: 4 dose series or single dose after 15 months of age

Kindergarten

- School Physical
- Lead Questionnaire
- Dental Exam
- Vision Exam
- Dtap: 4 or more doses with last being a booster after 4th birthday, or 3 doses if 7 years old or older and series started at 1 year or older.
- Polio: 4 or more doses with the last being a booster after 4th birthday, or 3 doses if 3rd dose was received at 4 years of age or older.
- MMR: 2 doses Varicella: 2 doses Hepatitis B: 3 doses

2nd Grade

• Dental Exam

6th Grade

- School Physical
- Dental Exam
- Tdap: 1 dose
- Polio: 3 or more doses, or 3 doses if the 3rd dose was received at age 4 years or older
- MMR: 2 doses
- Hepatitis B: 3 doses or 2 doses Adult recombivax-HB vaccine received at least 4 months apart if the series was started between the ages of 11-15.
- Varicella: 2 doses
- Meningococcal vaccine: 1 dose

9th Grade

- School Physical
- Dental Exam
- Tdap: 1 dose
- Polio: 4 doses, or 3 doses if the 3rd dose was received at age 4 years or older.
- MMR: 2 doses
- Hepatitis B: 3 doses or 2 doses Adult recombivax-HB vaccine received at least 4 months apart if the series was started between the ages of 11-15.
- Varicella: 2 doses
- Meningococcal vaccine: 1 dose

12th Grade

• Meningococcal vaccine: 2 doses, or 1 dose if the dose was initially received at 16 years old or older.
